Equipment Lending Policy

Reviewed and approved Biathlon Yukon Board

Purpose: The purpose of this policy is to provide guidelines in the loaning of Biathlon Yukon equipment to other non-profit organizations located in Whitehorse, Yukon.

SCOPE AND APPLICATION

- 1. Any loaning of equipment must be approved by either the President or Vice-President of Biathlon Yukon.
- 2. Equipment can only be loaned out to non-profit organizations located in the Whitehorse area and are referred to as the borrower.
- 3. Equipment that is to be loaned must be owned by Biathlon Yukon.

GUIDELINES

- 1. The borrower should have a demonstrated familiarity with the use of the type of equipment being borrowed and/or have operators that are trained in the use of the equipment.
- 2. The borrower understands (through written/verbal agreement) that Biathlon Yukon assumes no responsibility for any damage or injury that occurs through the use of the borrowed equipment.
- 3. The borrower should have a trailer suitable to transport the borrowed equipment. Snowmobile trailer or something similar should be appropriate for the snow machine or Tidd-Tech groomer.
- 4. The time period of the use of the loaned equipment must fit with Biathlon Yukon's own schedule. Some allowance will be made for the use during major competitions where there will be a priority placed on the request such as during Ski Nationals at WCCSC)

- 5. Any request must be made in writing (email, text or letter) to Biathlon Yukon with details on when and purpose of the equipment loan and when it will be returned and taking responsibility of the equipment and any damage (see #6).
- 6. The borrower must undertake to indemnify Biathlon Yukon for any damage caused by the operation of the equipment or to the equipment during the period its being borrowed.
- 7. The borrower is solely responsible to repair in a timely manner any damage caused by the borrower.
